The Pillars definition from United Nations

People

“We are determined to eradicate poverty and hunger, in all their forms and dimensions, and to ensure that all human beings can fulfill their potential in conditions of dignity and equality and in an environment healthy”. **SDGs: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5**

Planet

“We are determined to fight against the degradation of the planet, by resorting to sustainable consumption and production patterns, by ensuring the sustainable management of its natural resources and by taking urgent measures to combat climate change, so that can meet the needs of present and future generations”. **SDGs: 6, 12, 13, 14,15**

Prosperity

“We are determined to ensure that all human beings have prosperous and fulfilling lives and that economic, social and technological progress takes place in harmony with nature”.
SDGs: 7, 8, 9, 10,11

Peace

“We are determined to foster peaceful, just and inclusive societies, free from fear and violence. Indeed, there can be no sustainable development without peace and no peace without sustainable development”. **SDGs: 16**

Partnership

“We are determined to mobilize all means for the implementation of this Agenda through a revitalized Global Partnership for SD, which will be driven by a strengthened spirit of solidarity, where emphasis will be placed on the needs of the most deprived and of the most vulnerable, involving all countries, all stakeholders and all people”. **SDG: 17**
